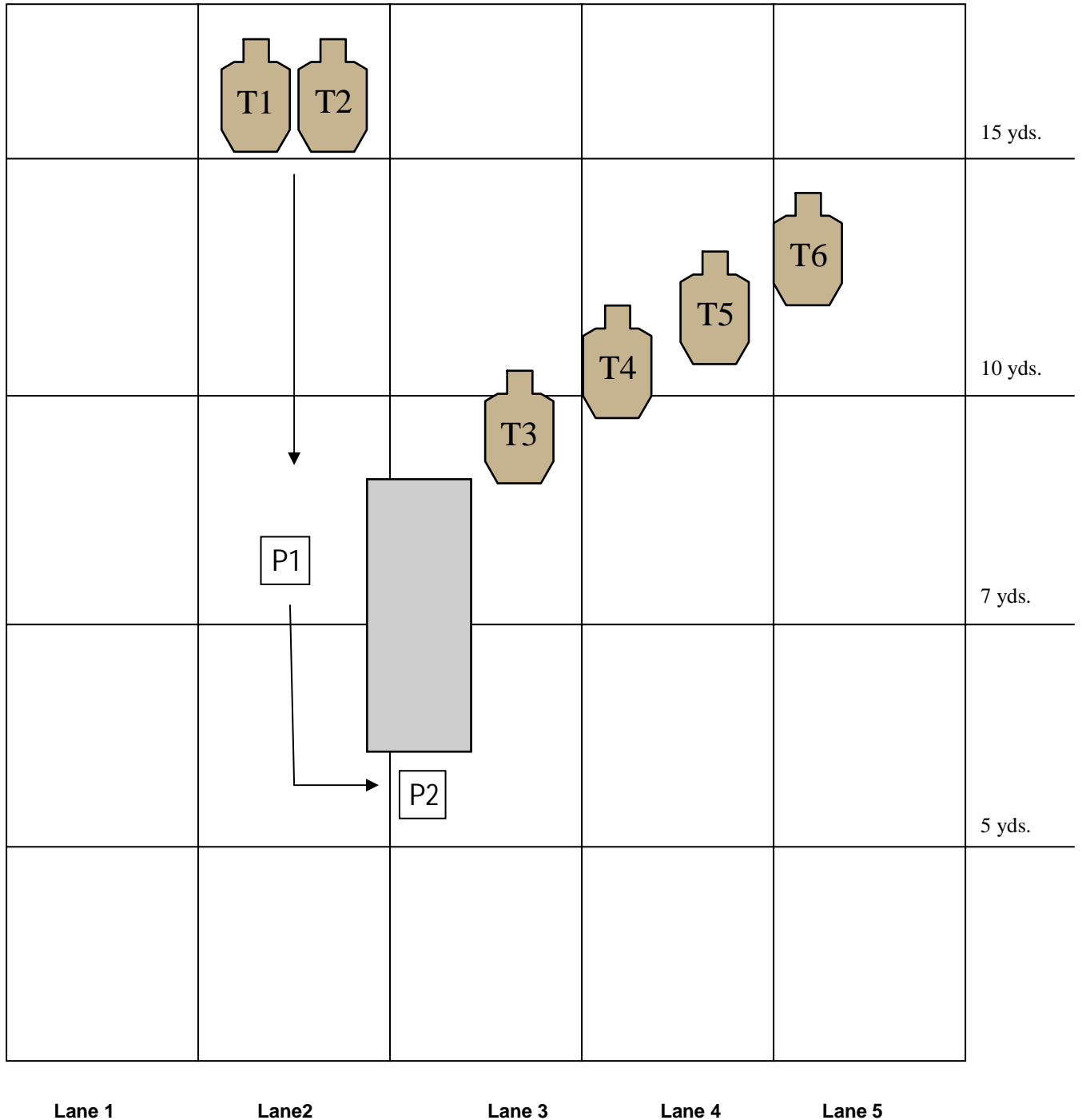


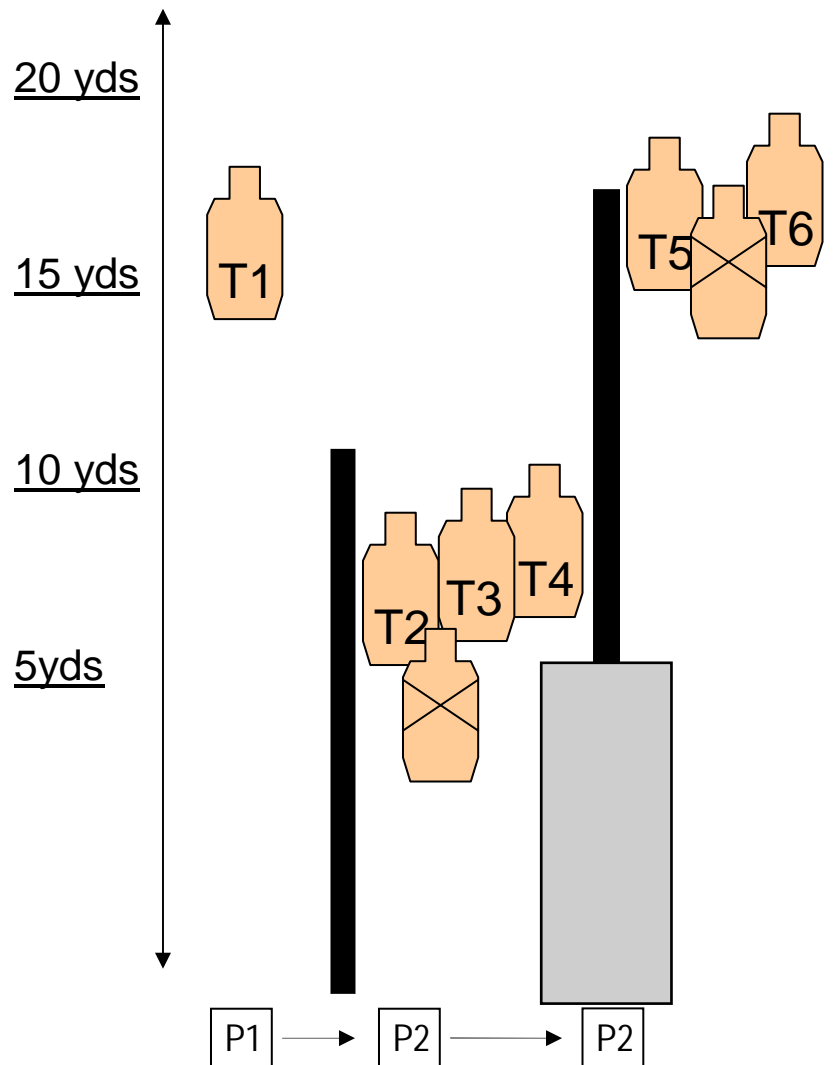
COF 3

You are in Nebraska Furniture Mart shopping with the wife. She is off looking at who knows what so you are just roaming the store. You are walking towards a gang of 6 delinquents that are harassing customers. Trying to avoid a confrontation you attempt to veer left around a display. At P1 you are confronted by two of the group (T1 & T2) who get bold knowing that you are not able to defend yourself as the store is posted. Your attempts to talk your way out fail and they pull knives and attack you. While backing away fire two shots each in tactical priority. When you get to the cover of the display you see the others coming after you as well. Address them T3 – T6) from cover with 2 shots each using tactical order. (12 rounds minimum)



COF4

- Distance from start to farthest targets, 15 yards.
- Vickers count
- Minimum rounds required, (13)
- Starting position is gun holstered,
- On signal, retrieve shotgun and fire 2 rounds into T1 from P1. Move to low cover, and engage T2-T4 with 3 rounds each in tactical priority around cover. Move to the wall on your right and engage T5 and T6 in tactical priority with 2 rounds each .

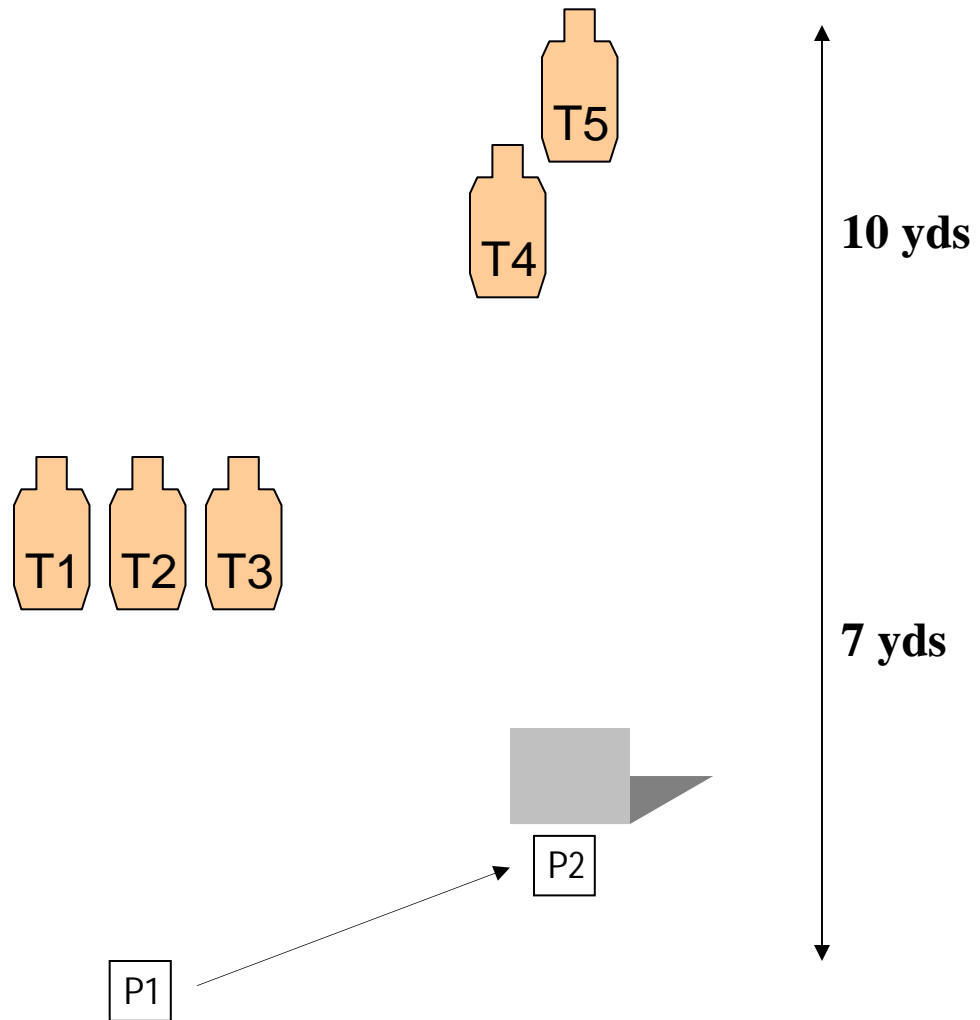


You are just adjusting your holster, preparing to leave a convenience store bathroom. You hear shouting from the front of the store. You open the door and are surprised by a bad guy that is obviously the lookout watching the back door. You have no time to draw but manage to overpower the man and take his shotgun.

You use his shot gun to shoot the bad guy at the other end of the hall. The gun only had two rounds so you drop it, pull your gun and step into the store and see 3 bad guys trying to exit the back door and you are forced to shoot when they rush you. Hearing another gunshot, you move across the room to your right and engage T5 and T6 in tactical order from the doorway.

COF2

- Max Distance: 15 yds
- Count: Vickers
- Min. Rounds: 15
- Position: Gun Holstered hands surrender position.
- On signal, draw and fire 3 rounds each T1-T3, two to the body, one to the head from P1, in tactical priority. Move to low cover at P2 and address T4 and T5 in tactical order with 3 shots each as well.

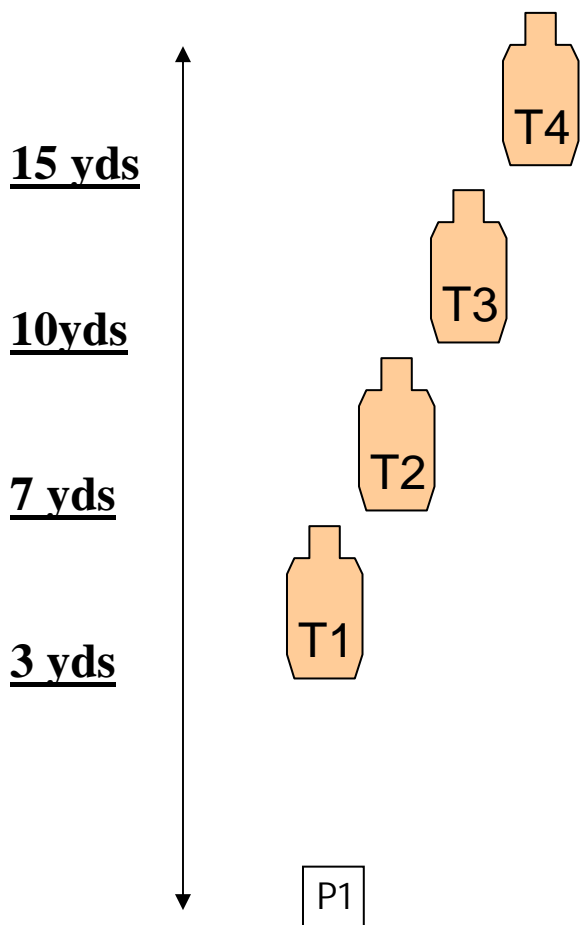


The Star, Kansas City, KS, 10/25/96

It was five against one at a Kansas City, Kansas, snack shop, but the armed citizen emerged unscathed. One of the would-be thieves was not so lucky. COF1

- Max Distance: 15 yds
- Count: Ltd. Vickers
- Max. Rounds: 16, Load first magazine to 8 rounds total.
- Position: Gun Holstered hands at sides,
- On signal, from P1, draw and fire 2 rounds each at T1-T4 strong hand only, then shoot T1-T4, 2 rounds each, weak hand only.



Your wife answers a classified ad in the paper and she is intrigued by the price and description of the furniture offered. She arranges for the two of you to go see it, but you are suspicious when the seller asks you to park on the side street and come to the backdoor of the apartment house. When you walk up the alley and round a privacy fence you are confronted by 4 attackers, 3 of them have clubs and the fourth has a small caliber rifle. They make no demands but immediately rush you. They are surprised as you draw and fire on them but the armed man manages to get off a lucky shot off into your strong side arm. Hopefully, you have just reloaded and are able to address the bad guys again with your weak hand.
